Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club athletes made history in Taekwondo.

Mumine Nur Goz, who competed on behalf of Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club in the Zekeriya Tutar Yıldızlar Turkish Taekwondo Championships, has been selected for the National Team with the gold medal she won, while Aleyna Nur İlli won the silver medal in the same tournament and is entitled to compete in the National Team selections again.

In Zekeriya Tutar Yıldızlar Turkish Taekwondo Championship held in Ankara between July 7 and 14, 2021, the most valuable athletes competing on behalf of **Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club** made their mark. Mumine Nur Goz, the athlete of Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club, who came on the mat representing Karaman in the championship where 1800 athletes competed, won the gold medal by defeating all her rivals by one point in the 55 kg category. Mumine Nur Goz has also been entitled to enter the National Team without selection due to this success. In the same championship, **Aleyna Nur İli**, who competed on behalf of Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club, defeated her rival and got to the finals in the 33 kg category, but she was defeated by her rival in the final with penalty points and left the tournament with a silver medal. Aleyna Nur İli is entitled to compete in the National Team selections again with the ranking she achieved in the tournament.

Our athletes shall compete for medals in Estonia

Recently, our Taekwondo National Team, which has achieved important success in international tournaments, shall start preseason training before the European Taekwondo Championship to be held in Estonia on August 2-21, 2021. Ali Can, the National Team Coach, a coach from Karaman, will manage the men's team at the Yıldızlar National Team Camp, which will start on August 2-20, 2021 in Konya, and Ayşegül Funda Alp, the Coach of the Duru Bulgur Performance Sports Club will manage the women's team.
